To Receive

Dear Friends of The Blessed Foundation,

It was an early day in spring and I was with a friend who asked me to just be with her while she processed some challenges in her life. Amid the tears and anxiety I sat listening. After some time she paused and said, I'm not letting you say anything. It was then, in a grace-filled moment, that I responded with these words: "All I have to offer you is to *receive* you." We both fell silent. It was a moment of ultimate clarity for both of us.

Since then, I have been contemplating this word *Receive* with new eyes. If you look up any quotes on receive it usually is paired opposite of giving, with giving being given the status of the greater virtue as in "Giving is more joyous than receiving". But after witnessing with my friend the transformative insight into being a receiver, my prayer was for Holy Wisdom to infuse this experience.

The realization that is slowly taking hold in my consciousness is that to be a Receiver encompasses and blesses giving and other experiences of relationship. To be a Receiver means more than listening and seeing the other.

It means that one must be totally open and vulnerable to the movement of God's grace in a way that allows the other to know, deeply to their core, that they are valuable. Within this realization of value, the other is able to allow hope to arise.

In the midst of this experience of grace I am becoming aware of how I receive another. This requires gentle observation and truth seeing. It means continually asking the question, until it becomes a part of my conscious nature, "How am I receiving you?" "How am I receiving all of creation?" Within that question looms responsibility to all that is above, below and on either side of me.

Right after writing this, I came across words of Richard Rohr, O.F.M. in his book Radical Grace (Daily Meditations) "*Prayer is learning how to receive.*"

I pray that you will be received. I pray that you will have the ability to receive. I pray that God will manifest in each of us the wonders of a God who continually receives us and is at one with us.


