Dear Friends of the Foundation,

I pondered what the theme for this year would be over the past few months. During that process I had the opportunity to pick and watch the blooming of a flower that has long captured my interest; the beautiful and intriguing "Bird of Paradise".





There was real joy as I carefully displayed this beautiful specimen in a low ceramic container, ideal for a single flower, so that I was finally able to observe it up close.

For two days I often stopped and looked at what I thought was the full bloom which

graced our table and I marveled at the delicacy and strength of this mysterious blossom.

On the third day, to my utter surprise, a second blossom, like the first, revealed itself as the first blossom relinquished its glory to give presence to the second. At this point, I looked more closely at the anatomy of this flower. There is a thick, hard,



pod or cocoon from which the blossoms emerge. And there was what appeared to me, a "tear drop" that formed as a bead where the cocoon splits in order for the flower to emerge.

A few days after the second, the third and final blossom emerged. The second blossom relinquished its presence to the third. And finally, after a couple of weeks, the fading of all three blossoms as it died with utter grace and beauty.



This experience soon reflected, for me, the revelation and maturity of our own life span. What do we truly hold within? How can we not only honor this sacred seed of our life but allow, co-operate and co-create to the full emergence of the Divine as it is revealed within each of us? The words of St. Paul come to mind; I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. Galations 2:20



If you are coming from the NORTH on I-71, there is a detour onto River Styx and Rt 18. The easiest way is to turn LEFT off of I-71 exit 218, stay in the center turn lane of the Exit. You will pass under I-71. Turn right at the very next street (MONTVILLE DRIVE)...There is a **Strickland's Ice Cream Shop** on the corner. Continue on Montville Drive until it ends onto Ridgewood Drive. Turn RIGHT onto Ridgewood. It will end at RIVER STYX ROAD. Turn LEFT onto River Styx Road to the address of the Foundation. 6605 River Styx Road on LEFT. See the Google Earth Map below. YELLOW MARKS THE WAY!

This detour is expected to be in effect for 90 days, beginning April 29th.
